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Chennai's first mall hotel has officially opened, adding a whole new facet to the city's hospitality industry. The Skywalk Hotel by Auromatrix has 20 rooms, and is situated on the fifth floor of Ampa Skywalk Mall.

The hotel has 24-hour room service, Wi-Fi, a doctor on call, safety lockers, three restaurants (Fuego, The Attic Cafe and Spice Mill) and a bar (Altitude 23.26"). The 238-sq.ft. rooms are well furnished, priced between Rs. 3,000 and Rs. 4,000 per night and centrally air-conditioned.

Fuego is a grill restaurant with an array of exotic dishes (octopus and emu meat are served here). While the ambience is mellow, the menu comes alive with flavours from various cuisines. There is also a traditional Indian menu.

“Grilled food is very popular now, and we don't use too much oil; everything is grilled on charcoal,” says Joshva Christopher, manager, Operations.

Spice Mill, the South Indian restaurant, offers cuisine from the four southern states, and includes kane rava fry and thakkali elumichai rasam. The Attic Café is a 24-hour multi-cuisine restaurant that has buffet and fine dining options. It will soon be coming up with an activity centre. Altitude 23.26” the pub, spread on two floors, will open shortly.
